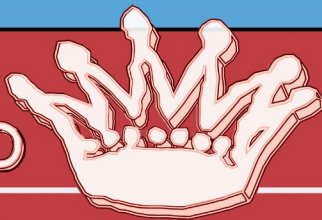

Amanda Blake Davis (she/her | Geoff) is an LA based actor and writer. She is an alum of The Second City in Chicago where she wrote and performed in five ETC revues including *Studs Terkel's Not Working*, for which she won a Jeff Award for Best Actress. She has written for *Wabbit!* and most recently Showtime's *Work in Progress*. She can be seen improvising with Heyday at The Westside Comedy theater.



Rebecca Larsen (she/her | Craigory | Director) Born and raised in Salt Lake City, Rebecca was a pre-medicine student before transferring into the Acting Program at the University of Utah. Since relocating to Los Angeles in 2004, she has worked as an actress, assistant director, producer, and director. At Sacred Fools, Rebecca has directed *Fast & Loose*, *The Box* (a non-linear theatrical experiment), and *The Joe and Joshua Show* at the 2017 Hollywood Fringe Festival. Rebecca became acquainted with *Gifted* as the co-curator of the New Works Development Program, and directed its world premiere in 2020.



Cj Merriman (she/her | Stan) Cj Merriman went to Webster University's Conservatory of Theatre Arts and got a BFA in Acting. She has worked with some great LA area companies like LOFT Ensemble, Burglars of Hamm, Theatricum Botanicum, Sacred Fools and is also an avid religious follower of the Hollywood Fringe Festival. Cj has gotten to try on a lot of theatrical hats: choreographer (*Trainwreck*, *Now or Neverland*, *Miravel*), director (*Dracula's Taste Test*), and producer (*Serial Killers*, *Come Back!*), but mostly loves herself some actin'. Some of her favorites include: *Night Witches* (HFF), *The Behavior of Broadus* (Burglars/Fools), *Watson* (Fools), and *The Poe Show* (HFF). You can currently catch her co-hosting the ONLY theatre podcast (*Theatre Theater*) with THREE GUYS writer J. Bailey Burcham and *Watson* castmate Scott Leggett. Cj says, "Words cannot begin to describe how excited I am that THREE GUYS, ONE GROUPON is getting a life at this year's Hollywood Fringe!"



Leigh Wulff (she/her | Ollie) is a performer and writer who's been bouncing around stages and screen in Los Angeles since 2007. A veteran of the sketch and improv scene, Leigh Wulff is a content creator and co-founder of Clean Plate Club Productions - a silly short form content collective. You can see her in two other productions at this year's Fringe: *Who's Afraid of David Lynch?* over at Three Clubs, and *Let's Get Silly* in the Broadwater Black

Box. Leigh has recently signed with the Colleen Cler Agency across the board! She is excited to get back up on a stage with these incredible actors, and hopes you get as much joy from this production as she has.

J. Bailey Burcham (he/him | Playwright) is a local playwright, director and producer. As a day job he is the Operations Manager of the Pasadena Playhouse. Bailey has won multiple writing competitions including his 1st and 2nd place wins in *Serial Killers* 2019 at The Broadwater (which spawned the play you are seeing now). He is also a teacher/director at Shakespeare Youth Fest LA and was part of the team that began the Kenyan chapter of the Festival in Kogelo. Scott Leggett (he/him | Producer) appeared in the modern farce *Tangerine Sunset* at Sacred Fools. He performed multiple characters in Burglars of Hamm's critically acclaimed production of *Resa Fantastisk Mystisk* which won Top of Fringe at the Hollywood Fringe Festival. He was Monster in *Cookie and the Monster* at the Hollywood Fringe Festival '15, which won Best Ensemble. He earned praise playing Roscoe "Fatty" Arbuckle opposite French Stewart in the critically acclaimed Pasadena Playhouse production of *Stoneface: The Rise and Fall and Rise of Buster Keaton*. Scott is a proud member of Sacred Fools where he played the titular character in *Watson: The Last Great Tale of the Legendary Sherlock Holmes* as well as its sequel. Other shows include *43 Plays for 43 Presidents* and *The Swine Show* in addition to numerous other productions. He studied theater at Penn State University and has appeared in several films, commercials and TV shows. Scott is also an accomplished director, having staged the hugely successful adaptation of Neil Gaiman's *Neverwhere* at Sacred Fools. He also directed *The Poe Show* which won Best Comedy at the Hollywood Fringe Festival '15, and *Skullduggery: The Musical Prequel to Hamlet*. He has also served as Co-Artistic Director of Sacred Fools.
